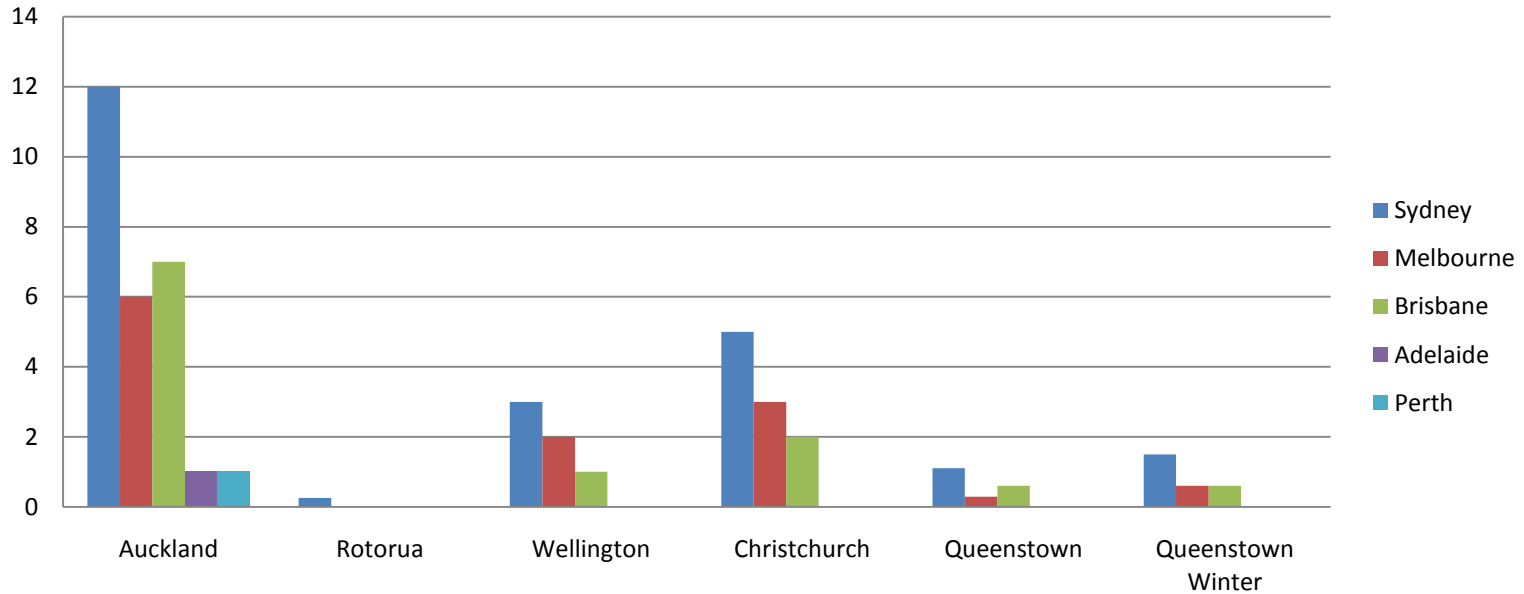

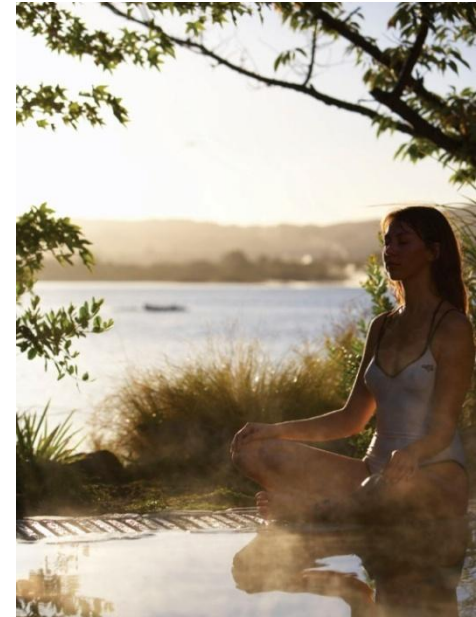
Auckland
